

Eligibility Criteria

Applicants must:

- 1. Be a 100 Cape Fear Black Men Chapter mentee, Collegiate 100 member or affiliate.
- 2. Have a minimum- 3.0 GPA.
- 3. Be enrolled or planning to attend a post-secondary institution in the fall semester of 2024 as a fulltime undergraduate student.

Application Packet Requirements

- 1. Official Transcript- Transcript must include all pages, show GPA and be legible.
- 2. Photograph-Photo must be a high resolution jpeg file suitable for publication (i.e. cap and gown head shot or other professionally dressed photo).
- **3.** Essay (500 Words Max, minimum 300 words) Please explain why you want to attend college and the advantages a college education will provide.
- 4. Career Goals- List your career goals.
- 5. Confirmation of Community Service Letter- Applicants are required to perform a minimum of 50 active service hours within the last 12 months preceding the application. Confirmation letter should be completed by the supervisor of the project on company's letterhead. Volunteering with the Red Cross, checking on the elderly, feeding the needy, use of zoom to plan community activities, or make podcasts on various subjects of interest to your community are some examples of acceptable community service.
- 6. Leadership Involvement- List and describe your leadership involvement over the last 4 years. Some examples of leadership are serving as President or an Officer in an organization or group. Serving as captain of Debate or an athletic team, starting a project to meet needs in the community.
